- We will identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
- We will describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans referring to mouth, tongue, teeth, oesophagus, stomach, small intestine and large intestine only
- We construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey

## RE

- To know what it means to be Hindu in Britain today.
- To know about Hindu rituals, ceremonies and traditions.
- To know how Hindus celebrate Diwali in Leicester.
- To know how Jesus showed Christians how to live their lives.
- To know how Christians celebrate Easter.
- To know the story of the resurrection.

## HISTORY

- We will learn that the 'War of the Roses' was a civil war between the houses of Lancaster and York.
- To know the Tudor Monarchs and be able to place them on a timeline.

## PSHE

- We will learn how to recognise, express and manage feelings.
- We will learn how to carry out basic first aid including for burns, scalds, cuts, bleeds, choking, asthma attacks or allergic reactions.
- We will know that we must remain calm and in an emergency, know when it is appropriate to use first aid or call the emergency services.

## PE

## MUSIC

## MATHS

- We will apply our knowledge of multiplication to enable us to multiply a 2/3 digit number by a 1 digit number.
- We will learn how to solve division calculations using the part whole mode.
- We will learn how to find the area of a shape by counting the squares.
- We increase our knowledge and understanding of fractions and decimals.

## GEOGRAPHY

- We will learn about the importance of the oceans as well as the human impact. We will learn about the Great Barrier Reef and its importance to our eco system.
